



AP 120-Metal Prep

Application Information

Please read carefully and understand the following instructions.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

AP120 is a water-based metal prep product specifically designed for the following POR-15 Coatings:-

Glisten PC
Whitecote
All Hardnose Paints.

AP120 should always be used when painting directly on to aluminium and other reactive metals such as brass and copper. When used properly according to directions, it will ensure a perfect bond every time.

AP120 is not flammable and has no flashpoint, but protective gloves and goggles should be worn when using it.

DIRECTIONS:

Spray or brush AP120 on to metal to be painted. Keep wet for no more than two (2) minutes, wash off with water and dry the surface thoroughly with a fresh clean cloth. The metal can now be painted.

Leaving AP120 on aluminium for more than two minutes may result in a slight darkening of the aluminium surface.

Keep the AP120 bottle tightly closed when not in use.

NOTE:

ALWAYS carry out a test piece first, as different types of aluminium can react completely differently, even the same grade from different manufacturers can have varying reactions. Special care should be taken with castings as many of these contain magnesium which can make the alloy more reactive.

WARNING:

Keep out of the reach of children.

FIRST AID:

Eye Contact:

Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for 5 to 20 minutes occasionally lifting eyelids. Get medical attention if irritation or symptoms of overexposure persist.

Ingestion:

If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Drink water. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
