RE-DYING CANVAS INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Always do a trial test patch

Please read all directions before beginning your canvas restoration project.
Do not hesitate to call or email if you have any questions

Rubber gloves & eye protection are recommended.

Rinse with soap and water in case of contact with skin.

Do not ingest.

Leatherique Canvas Restoration Dye is a revolutionary, complex polymer coating. It is highly acclaimed and gives excellent results when used according to directions. The Leatherique Canvas Dye will re-colour your existing canvas and at the same time it will waterproof it. You can even change colours.

All the dye must be poured into a bowl to be mixed thoroughly to get an even dye colour as some colour pigments are heavier than others and settle at the bottom of the bottle.

You will need

- Leatherique canvas Dye (1 lt covers approx 10 sq / metre)
- A plastic bowl to hold all the dye.
- A bucket and mild detergent soap.
- Mop and soft broom or sponge and brush (depending on the size of the canvas.)
- Hose or bucket for water.
- Brush or sponge to apply the dye.
- Latex gloves.
- Mixing paddle.

STEP 1

Wash the canvas well with the mild detergent and water.

Use the brush or broom and give it a good scrub. This is to get rid of dirt and anything else that has deposited itself on the canvas.

Rinse well with fresh water to get rid of the soapy residue.

Hang up or let it dry.

Makes sure it hasn't picked up any more dirt during the drying period.
(from a wet floor, grass etc)

STEP 2

Shake the bottle well (there is a marble in it to assist).

Pour **ALL** the dye into the plastic container and mix well. The colour pigments settle at different levels and it needs mixing to maintain a constant colour. This is also why you need to mix **all** the dye, once mixed you can pour some back into the bottle if you're not going to use all of it.

STEP 3

Once you're happy with the colour mix dip a sponge / brush and start applying it in light strokes. Less is better. Rather give it two light coats than one heavy one.

Remember you're dyeing it not painting it.

Stir the dye every few minutes to keep the pigments well mixed.

Allow to dry for approximately one hour.

STEP 4

Apply a second coat or paint the inside.

Allow to dry for 48 hrs before folding.

Other PPC Products that work.

POR-15 Rust Preventative Paint.

If you have rust problems on the caravan, trailer, boat trailer car or around the home the POR-15 Rust Preventative Paint is a "Hammer Tough" coating that seals the metal from any moisture and air and therefore stops any rust, permanently. It's been sold in the United States for over 30 years (over 12 years in Aus. by PPC) and well known amongst car restorers.

SW 2 Oil

For those difficult to get to rusty places where you can't paint. This is similar to a fish oil but a chemical version that hardens and seals the surface. It has an excellent capillary action and it will spread into the most inaccessible places. A great product to spray into the bottoms of doors. Chassis channels etc.

Leatherique leather restoring.

There are two stages to the Leatherique restoration process.

The first is the Rejuvenator Oil and Prestine Clean. These products will restore, clean and bring back the suppleness to you car seats, lounges, leather wear etc. This stops the leather cracking. It's not just a surface cleaner but gets right into the leather and pushes the dirt out.

Apply the Rejuvenator oil and allow to soak in. Then apply the Prestine Clean on a wet cloth and clean the seats.

The second is to re-dye and crack fill, if necessary to bring back that new look.

PPC will match to the existing colours and in a fairly simple DIY you can restore the leather to it's original look.
